
## What is District 36?

- A service organization that includes all AA groups in North Bend, Snoqualmie, Preston, Fall City, Carnation, and Duvall.
- Elected trusted servants include a District Committee Member (DCM), a Secretary, a Treasurer, District Committee Chairs, and General Service Representatives (GSR) from each AA group.
- The District organizes events, conducts AA business, keeps our meeting schedule current, and maintains our website (SnoValleyAA.org).
- Along with the GSR, the District is a member of the Area 72 assembly, which conducts the business for AA in all of Western Washington.



## What is a GSR?

- A GSR represents the AA group and carries the group conscience to the District and Area service organizations.
- The GSR makes regular reports to their AA Group on District and Area business.
- GSR attend District meetings and Area Assemblies and vote on issues affecting AA as a whole.

## What can groups do to support District 36?

- Elect and send a GSR to the District Meeting (first Tuesday of each month).
- Tell the District about your group events for posting on the website (webstuff@snovalleyaa.org).
- Tell the District how we can support your meeting and help the alcoholic who still suffers (dcm@snovalleyaa.org).
